






What is an Energy Master Plan?

 - a. Energy Upgrades (++ Efficiency)
 - b. Renewable Energy
- A plan to reduce energy usage, cost and emissions by 50% by 2030
- Funded by <u>SEAI</u> in the <u>Sustainable Energy</u>
 <u>Communities</u> scheme





 - Promoting Solar PV in homes, farms



- bottom up (distributed gen+storage)





